TWENTY-FIVE YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY FOR FIBER-CLASSIC® FRENCH PATIO DOOR

THE FIBER-CLASSIC FRENCH PATIO DOOR:**

The Fiber-Classic French Patio Door manufactured by THERMA-TRU, which is defined as those door faces surrounding the glass, is warranted to be free of splitting, denting and warp defects that exceed ANSII/NWMA I.S.1.1-80. The terms of this express warranty, except as hereinafter provided, extend for twenty-five (25) years from date of first purchase at retail by user, excluding failures which are the result of (1) use with system components (except for wood jambs and mullions detailed to Thermo-Tru specifications) other than those manufactured by THERMA-TRU; (2) accident or improper use; (3) fire, corrosive fume, condensate damage or other acts of God; (4) water damage to wood sills or rails; or (5) improper installation.

THERMA-TRU will furnish a replacement for a door which is defective or, at its option, refund the purchase price of the door in lieu of furnishing a replacement. No labor or installation is included.

THE FIBER-CLASSIC FRENCH PATIO DOOR LITE:**

The Fiber-Classic French Patio Door Lite with exclusive monolithic construction is warranted for a period of ten (10) years against insulated glass failure, glass breakage and seal failure under normal use and service, subject to the excluded failures noted above.

THE FIBER-CLASSIC FRENCH PATIO DOOR SYSTEM:**

The Fiber-Classic French Patio Door System consists of the following components: (1) Thermo-Tru French Patio doors; (2) Thermo-Tru weatherstripping, adjustable strike plate, and foamed corner seal pads applied to a wood frame or mull manufactured to Thermo-Tru detail specifications; (3) Thermo-Tru hinges; (4) a Thermo-Tru sill; (5) Thermo-Tru door bottoms; and (6) if a door lite is used, a Thermo-Tru door lite. All Thermo-Tru components, with the exception of weatherstrip and corner seal pads, are identified by the name "Thermo-Tru". (See "How to Identify a Thermo-Tru Door System"). The entire Fiber-Classic French Patio Door System, except those portions of the door and door lite described above, will be free of defects in workmanship and material or THERMA-TRU will replace it, at no charge, for up to five (5) years. The finish on the hinges is also warranted to be free of rusting, chalking and peeling for the five-year system warranty period.

Warranty Instructions

In the event of a warranty claim, send a written notice of any defect occurring within the warranty period by certified U.S. Mail to THERMA-TRU CORP., 1684 Woodlands Dr., Suite 150, Maumee, Ohio 43537 - immediately upon the discovery of the defect. The written notice must include:

- (a) Catalog number and description of door.
- (b) Name and address of owner and installer.
- (c) Proof of sale.
- (d) DETAILED explanation of defect.

If THERMA-TRU believes the Fiber-Classic French Patio Door Unit is defective within the terms of the warranty, THERMA-TRU may, at its option: (1) furnish a replacement door unit component from stock (installation not included), or (2) refund the purchase price of the door unit component, exclusive of any installation charges.

If the Fiber-Classic French Patio Door System purchased includes a Thermo-Tru lockset and/or wood grilles, in either event, such lockset and/or wood grilles are warranted to be free of defects in workmanship and material, subject to the recited exclusions for the same five-year door unit warranty period.

HOW TO IDENTIFY A FIBER-CLASSIC FRENCH PATIO DOOR SYSTEM:

Thermo-Tru Door System components can be identified as follows: (1) door slab - Thermo-Tru mark stamped at eye level on the lock stile; (2) weatherstrip - extruded compression bulb, bronze in color; corner seal pad - closed-cell foam filled wedge construction; security strike plate - Thermo-Tru mark stamped on the fixed plate. (Non-use of Thermo-Tru strike plate does not invalidate warranty.); (3) hinges - Thermo-Tru mark stamped into hinge leaf; (4) Thermo-Tru sill - Thermo-Tru mark stamped in the bottom or end; aluminum and adjustable sills - Thermo-Tru mark stamped on the front corner of the aluminum ramp; (5) door bottom - extruded with compression bulb one side, single fin opposite side, bronze in color; (6) glass - Thermo-Tru mark in the temper blaze in the bottom corner; Fiber-Classic doorlite frames - Thermo-Tru mark stamped in the bottom or end. Your Thermo-Tru warranty is valid only when all of the above-identified Thermo-Tru components are utilized.

THERE IS NO OTHER EXPRESS WARRANTY. IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING THOSE OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, ARE LIMITED TO ONE (1) YEAR FROM PURCHASE. THIS IS THE EXCLUSIVE REMEDY, AND LIABILITY FOR CONSEQUENTIAL AND INCIDENTAL DAMAGES UNDER ANY AND ALL WARRANTIES ARE EXCLUDED TO THE EXTENT EXCLUSION IS PERMITTED BY LAW. SOME STATES DO NOT ALLOW LIMITATIONS ON HOW LONG AN IMPLIED WARRANTY LASTS, OR THE LIMITATION OR EXCLUSION OF CONSEQUENTIAL OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES, SO THE ABOVE LIMITATION OR EXCLUSION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU.

THIS WARRANTY GIVES YOU SPECIFIC LEGAL RIGHTS, AND YOU MAY ALSO HAVE OTHER RIGHTS WHICH VARY FROM STATE TO STATE.
